Overview

Integrated Skills in English (ISE) by Trinity London (ESOL), Year 12

The course is for pupils who have previously taken an ESOL exam at Entry 2 or Entry 3 levels and would like to achieve Level 1 qualifications. The exam assesses all four language skills – reading, writing, speaking and listening. The exam is divided into two modules: Reading and Writing, and Speaking and Listening. To get a full certificate, pupils must pass both modules.

During the course, pupils read a wide variety of texts and are required to write different types of texts. The reading texts reflect the range of subjects a pupil may encounter in an educational or academic setting and the way that he or she needs to find, select and report relevant and appropriate information. The writing tasks reflect the kind of activities a pupil does in a school such as essay writing.

Pupils also develop speaking and listening skills. The integrated speaking and listening tasks reflect the kind of activities a pupil does at school, or college. Additionally, the Independent listening tasks reflect the way that a student finds, selects and reports relevant and appropriate information in an educational or academic setting.
