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Overview

Students follow the OCR A Advanced GCE course studying 4 modules over the 2 year course. Students build upon the skills they have acquired at GCSE to address significant events in British history and around the world. The course enables students to foster their skills of source enquiry, creating and assessing lines of historical arguments and the critic of historical interpretation. This provides students with a respected qualification for their future careers and prepares them for study post KS5.

The modules which students follow are:

- Unit 1 –England 1547-1603: the later Tudors
- Unit 2 –Democracy and Dictatorships in Germany 1919-1963
- Unit 3 – Popular Culture and witch craze of the 16th and 17th centuries
- Unit 4 –Independent Study: Pupils research and write their own enquiry question

Units 1 is worth 25% of the final GCE qualification assessed at the end of the two-year qualification.

Unit 2 is worth 15% of the final GCE qualification assessed at the end of the two-year qualification.

Unit 3 is worth 40% of the final GCE qualification assessed at the end of the two-year qualification.

Unit 4 is worth 20% of the final GCE qualification assessed at the end of the two year qualification.
