## Coronavirus update - school closure to most pupils

## Following on from my last update, I'm now writing to let you know that **we have been instructed to** close the school to almost all children after this Friday, 20<sup>th</sup> March 2020, until further notice.

As advised by the government, we will do all that we can to stay open for the children of key workers (e.g. NHS staff, police, others in frontline services) and children with certain needs. We have worked hard over the last twenty four hours to establish which children may fall into one of these categories and will contact those involved directly. All other children will need to stay at home, so we ask that you do not send your child into school from Monday onwards. Please note that this is a national closure – as you may have heard in the news – so while it is a challenging situation, we are not alone. We'll re-open fully as soon as we can and will let you know when this is by text message, on our website and through social media channels.

Your child's learning is of course important to us and we will continue to help your child to learn by using online platforms to set appropriate work. All students have access to Show My Homework, which will be used to direct them to resources to use at home.

If your child does not have access to the internet, please let their Head of Year know as soon as possible so that we can make alternative arrangements for offsite learning. All school events will be cancelled for the duration of the school closure. It has also been announced that no external examinations will take place this summer. We are awaiting further details of how grades will be awarded to year 11 and 13 students, which we will share with you as soon as we can.

This is as much as we know at the moment and we appreciate your continued patience with us as we deal with this ever-changing situation. We understand that this latest news will have an impact on you and your family and it's far from ideal, but we'll continue to keep in touch with any updates as the situation develops.
