Arrangements for Collection of Exam Results for Year 11 - Update

Year 11 **GCSE** results can be collected on **Thursday 20th August 2020 from 9.00a.m.**

Results from other qualifications (including BTEC and CNAT) will now not be available to collect at this time as these are under review by the examination boards. We will re-issue a full set of results as soon as we are able to.

Year 10 and Sixth Form can also collect any GCSE results at the same times.

Control measures will be in place, including asking all pupils to wash their hands as they enter the building and controlling the flow of pupils as they arrive to pick up results, including operating a one-way system. Please collect all results from the main hall.
