Dear Parent/Carer,

We are delighted to see the school open to all year groups — we have certainly missed the pupils over the last few, very difficult months. We are very proud of the way in which our young people have started back in the new academic year. We appreciate that the new way of working in year group bubbles is strange at first, but we are very pleased with the way pupils have responded and look forward to working with them to gradually return things to normal when it is safe to do so. We know that things are not perfect and we are working hard to improve things as much as we can without compromising the safety of pupils or staff.

It is going to be a long and challenging year as we try to make up for the time we have lost, but I want to reassure pupils, parents and carers that we have a progressive plan which will gradually get things back to normal and support pupils to make accelerated progress without overwhelming them. Initially we are focussing on re-establishing routines and ensuring that pupils are engaged in learning while also focusing on any mental health issues which may have emerged during the period of lockdown.

It is clear from the news that many challenges lie ahead and that we all need to be vigilant and look out for the symptoms of coronavirus. If your child or anyone in your household displays any of the symptoms below, then everyone should self-isolate and take a test which can be arranged by telephoning 119.

The main symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are:

- A high temperature (around 38°C or above) this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back.
- A new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual).
- A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste this means you have noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.

We have regular updates from the local public health team and they have reiterated the importance of looking for the distinct symptoms outlined above and not to confuse these with seasonal colds, sore throats and runny noses.









We are continuing to work with Aspens, our school caterers, to develop and improve the offer to all pupils. As part of our control measures, it is important that payments for meals are made online. The use of the online system to add money to accounts for pupils who pay for school lunches is strongly recommended. More information is available on the school website:

Canteen staff will look up pupils on the system to process payments (pupils receiving free school meals will have their normal daily allocation). Pupils can pre-order a meal if they obtain an order form in advance from the school kitchen. We are installing additional drinking water points around school so please make sure your child has a water bottle if they want to access a drink from the water coolers.

Over recent months there have been some aspects of school life which have continued as they normally would in spite of the challenging circumstances. A number of staff: Mr Azad, Miss Everitt, Mrs Harris, Mr Kumar, Mr Law, Mr Miah, Mrs Murphy, Mrs Teladia and Mr Timmis left the school at the end of the summer term. We are grateful for the dedication and commitment which these staff have shown to the pupils at Blue Coat and wish them all well for the future. We would also like to wish Miss Wootton a happy retirement after many years' service in school.
