Between February 13th – 17th West Midlands Violence Reduction Partnership have organised County Lines and Criminal Exploitation Awareness Training sessions for parents, carers, community members and faith leads.

County Lines is a way to describe a specific type of criminal exploitation. This is where gangs and organised crime networks exploit children to sell drugs. They are often forced to travel to different counties, and they use dedicated mobile phone 'lines' to sell these drugs. This is where the term comes from.

This FREE awareness training programme aims to develop and improve our understanding of the threat from County Lines and Criminal Exploitation.
