Dear Parent/Carer,

Term Dates 2025/26

Over the course of the past few months, we have been reviewing the rhythm of the school year and concluded that we need to make some changes to ensure that we maximise the use of the time we have available in school with the students. The length of the Autumn Term has, for a long time, been a challenge to schools and the productivity of students has been difficult to sustain over such a long period of time. I am also aware that the placement of training days across the year can have a disruptive impact on the weeks where they fall. It is with all of this in mind that we have agreed a plan with governors to include a two week half term in October. We will only take one traditional training day at the beginning of the school year to carry out statutory training with all other staff training being spread across the whole of the year, outside of normal school time, which we also think will be beneficial. We will continue to align with the term dates for Walsall Council as far as possible. The term dates for 2025/26 at Blue Coat will be:
