Overview

Component 1: Human Lifespan Development

In this component, you will learn about how people grow and develop throughout their life, covering all of the life stages from infancy to adulthood. This will include their PIES development (physical, intellectual, emotional and social) t and the different factors that may affect an individual's growth and development. An individual's development can be affected by major life events, such as marriage, parenthood or moving to a new house and you will learn about how people adapt to these changes, as well as the types and sources of support that can help them.

This will be assessed through coursework, which will be internally assessed and externally moderated. You will complete the tasks between January and June. There are 60 marks available for this unit.

Following completion of this unit, you will begin Component 2: Health and Social Care Services and Values

In this unit you will learn and develop an understanding of the different types of health and social care services and the barriers that make it difficult for people to access these services. You will also learn about the skills, attributes and values required to provide care for others.
