Subject: Health and Social Care

Overview

You will continue with **Component 2: Health and Social Care Services and Values** that was started in the Summer of Year 10.

In this unit you will learn and develop an understanding of the different types of health and social care services and the barriers that make it difficult for people to access these services.
You will also learn about the skills, attributes and values required to provide care for others.

This will be assessed through coursework tasks from September to December. They will be internally assessed and externally moderated. There are 60 marks available.

Following completion of Component 2, you will begin **Component 3: Health and Wellbeing**
You will learn about the factors that impact health and wellbeing, such as lifestyle factors, environmental factors. You will also learn about physiological indicators used to measure health, such as blood pressure, what a person-centred approach to improving health and wellbeing means and looks like and recommendations for improving health and wellbeing.

This will be assessed through a 2-hour exam in the Summer term.
