Year: 7 Subject: French

Overview

In Year 7, students learn the basics of French, starting initially with simple conversations and useful vocabulary, such as numbers, alphabet, colours, people, family, likes and dislikes, the time, animals and school. We ensure that they have essential survival vocabulary and that they have a basic understanding of sentence formation in French. Students who have previously studied French in Primary School develop their knowledge further and apply their learning to new scenarios, songs and texts. We put a strong focus on pronunciation and developing spoken confidence.

Students will cover important grammar, such as the verbs avoir and être, and understand the importance of verb conjugation and adjective agreement. This provides the foundation for more in-depth grammatical application in Year 8.
