Subject: RE and Worldviews

Overview

In KS3, students study a wide range of religions and world views. The aim is to help students better understand the world around them, their own world views and how religion impacts everyday life. Students are encouraged to share their own views, listen to others and learn from faiths. The curriculum is designed to reflect the rich diversity of religions and worldviews in the Blue Coat Family. The year 9 curriculum is based in theology. Students will also start to study AQA GCSE Full Course in February of year 9.

In year 9 students will study-

- What it means to be Jewish in the 21st Century
- Biblical Wisdom- Job, Problem of Evil, St Paul
- What pilgrimage looks like in different faiths
- GCSE Paper 1- Study of Islamic Beliefs
- GCSE Paper 1- Study of Islamic Practices

To support students, we work on developing a range of theological, philosophy and sociological skills such as scriptural analysis, evaluation, the ability to express their own opinions respectfully as well as fostering independent study skills.
